Who: At this time we have specific openings for Indigenous youth ages 16 (with parent/guardian consent) to 29 from **Labrador, Manitoba, Northwest Territories, and British Columbia**. Indigenous youth living with or affected by HIV/AIDS and/or other sexually transmitted and blood-borne infections (STBBI's) are strongly encouraged to apply. **Public disclosure of HIV or STBBI status is not a requirement to be part of NIYCHA.** Inuit, Metis and Indigenous young men who are Two-Spirit, transgendered or gender non-conforming are also strongly encouraged to apply!

What: NIYCHA represents Indigenous youth from across Canada that are working together to carry out a National Indigenous Youth Strategic Action Plan for HIV/AIDS and other STBBI's. A partnership between the Canadian Indigenous AIDS Network (CAAN) and Native Youth Sexual Health Network (NYSHN), NIYCHA represents Indigenous youth leadership in all issues of HIV/AIDS, STBBI's, sexual health and harm reduction.
